A Word on Prayer:

We have an enemy. A real enemy that is prowling around like a hungry lion,
seeking to devour us (1 Peter 5:8). He intends to steal our joy, kill our faith, and
destroy our families (John 10:10). It is essential that we put on the full armor of
God so that we can stand our ground against the devils schemes (Ephesians 6:10-
18).

In the movie, *War Room*, Clara's husband, Leo, was in the military. He worked on
military strategy, looking at the enemy and then making a plan for how to fight.
Learning from that, Ms. Clara implemented some strategies to fight in prayer.

Jesus teaches us how to pray in Matthew 6:5-15, instructing us to pray in secret
without trying to get the attention from others. This is the basis of Ms. Clara's
War Room. She, and later Elizabeth, cleared out a closet, and spent time in there
alone with the Lord. You may not have a closet you can clean out, but you can
have a specific chair, or space in your home where you regularly go to fight in
prayer. A place where you can remove all distractions. Acknowledge He is God
and you are in need of Him. Lay your burdens at His feet. Pray scripture back to
God. He has given us the resources to fight – take advantage of them!
